A BJA Three Star Event

Eligibility: All competitors must hold a current licence: **No Licence – No Contest – No Exceptions**

SOUTHERN AREA must be specified as the area in the competitors licence and the competitor must have been a member of the Southern Area for at least 90 days (since 11/07/2010). BJC and AJA competitors must compete in the Area Trials that the location of their club is based.

White suits only for the area trials but note that blue suits will be required for the British Championships.

Proof of age will be required – passport or birth certificate.

Group 1 Boys PRE CADET	12 and 13 Yrs old Born: 1997/98	Green belt (10 th mon) and above -30 -34 -38 -42 -46 -50 -55 -60 -66 +66kg
Group 2 Girls PRE CADET	12 and 13 Yrs old Born: 1997/98	Green belt (10 th mon) and above -32 -36 -40 -44 -48 -52 -57 -63 +63kg
Group 3 Boys CADET	14 and 15 Yrs old Born: 1995/96	Green belt (10 th mon) and above -38 -42 -46 -50 -55 -60 -66 -73 -81 -90 +90kg
Group 4 Girls CADET	14 and 15 Yrs old Born: 1995/96	Green belt (10 th mon) and above -40 -44 -48 -52 -57 -63 -70 +70kg
Group 5 Young Men	16, 17 & 18 Yrs old Born: 1992/93/94	Blue Belt (13 th mon or 2 nd Kyu) and Above POINTS SCORING -55 -60 -66 -73 -81 -90 -100 +100kg
Group 6 Young Women	16, 17 & 18 Yrs old Born: 1992/93/94	Blue Belt (13 th mon or 2 nd Kyu) and Above POINTS SCORING -44 -48 -52 -57 -63 -70 -78 +78kg

**Shime Waza are permitted but Kansetsu waza are NOT permitted in groups 3 and 4
Shime Waza and Kansetsu Waza are permitted in groups 5 and 6**

Medals will not be presented at this event. The top 4 competitors in each category from the Southern Area Trials will form the selection criteria for the Southern Area quota of competitors at the 2010 British Championships to be held on the 9th & 10th October 2010 at Ice Sheffield. Players must enter the British Championships at the weight that they qualified at. No change of weight will be allowed at the British Championships.

All successful players will be advised to enter the British Championships. Entry form must be completed, payment made and proof of British Citizenship/Date of Birth provided. Completed entry forms or online entry must be forwarded to the BJA head office by Monday 27th September 2010. Late entries will **NOT** be accepted. All entries will be cross referenced against the area trials results to confirm eligibility.

Entry fees £18.00 for the British Championships are non refundable under any circumstances.

Girls 10.30 to 11.00 a.m Young Woman 11.00 to 11.30 a.m

**Boys and Young Men 0.5Kg allowance for trousers.
Girls and Young Women 0.6Kg allowance for trousers and tee shirt.**
